Continuing our charge to maintain our campus facilities responsibly, we turn our focus to The Village – our award-winning assisted living residence, which is 100% dedicated to serving the special needs of people with memory impairment and dementia.

Since opening its doors in 2001, The Village has been home – or a short-term home away from home – to more than 570 seniors with memory impairment. This staggering number of people served is due in part to our mission-driven commitment to offer respite care – a vital caregiver relief service that provides short-term lodging and personal care to guests who stay with us briefly. Thus, The Village has experienced far more wear-and-tear in 15 years than a conventional assisted living community would.
